It happened so quickly. My friend, who builds houses in his spare time as an additional source of income, was finishing up late one evening the shingles on his latest project. He had been up most of the previous night as one of his children was sick. The lack of sleep and being exhausted resulted in a mistake. Instant pain shot through his body. What had happened? He was using what I call a 'nail gun' and he had accidentally nailed his hand to the roof. Later he told me that he yelled so loud the family living across the street heard him.

My friend experienced great pain that day but what my friend experienced was only a VERY TINY FRACTION of the pain our Lord felt on the cross. He was not nailed to the cross with a small single roofing nail. He was nailed with what would have been crude Roman nails which were usually several inches long. He had the crown of thorns on his head pressed down on his head. He had been beaten by the soldiers. He had heard the jeering mob yelling for his crucifixion. With all the pain He felt that day, in my opinion His deepest pain was the burden of our sins placed upon Him that day. The perfect sinless One was now loaded down not with His sins (which were zero) but our sins. He paid the price for our sins!

Through the eyes of faith, when we look upon the cross may we all view the greatest sacrifice ever paid. A sacrifice marked with tremendous pain. A sacrifice made possible by His great love.

Something happen last week that was a first for me. I received a thank you letter regarding our online ministry. That wasn't the first as I often receive emails of appreciation about our classes.
