A temple unsurpassed in beauty, would become a national symbol of Israel's special relationship with the true God. Even though the two structures are different as the tabernacle was mobile and the temple has a fixed location structure, the temple and the tabernacle are similar in design, multiple stories and a grand porch are two major additions in the case of the temple.

This week we will read about an agreement between Solomon and King Hiram of Tyre, who provided the skilled workers to fashion much of the materials which were provided by Tyre. Sometime later, another man by the same name of Hiram will be brought from Tyre to do the brass work for the temple's furnishing. Altogether, the temple was built to be beyond description, a true symbol of majesty and beauty.

Also, this week in **BSME** we wrap up our study of Proverbs. I hope you have gained from these lessons on the Proverbs and perhaps you have memorized a proverb or two to use in your own daily life.
