This week we will read about an agreement between Solomon and King Hiram of Tyre, who provided the skilled workers to fashion much of the materials which were provided by Tyre. Sometime later, another man by the same name of Hiram will be brought from Tyre to do the brass work for the temple's furnishing. Altogether, the temple was built to be beyond description, a true symbol of majesty and beauty.

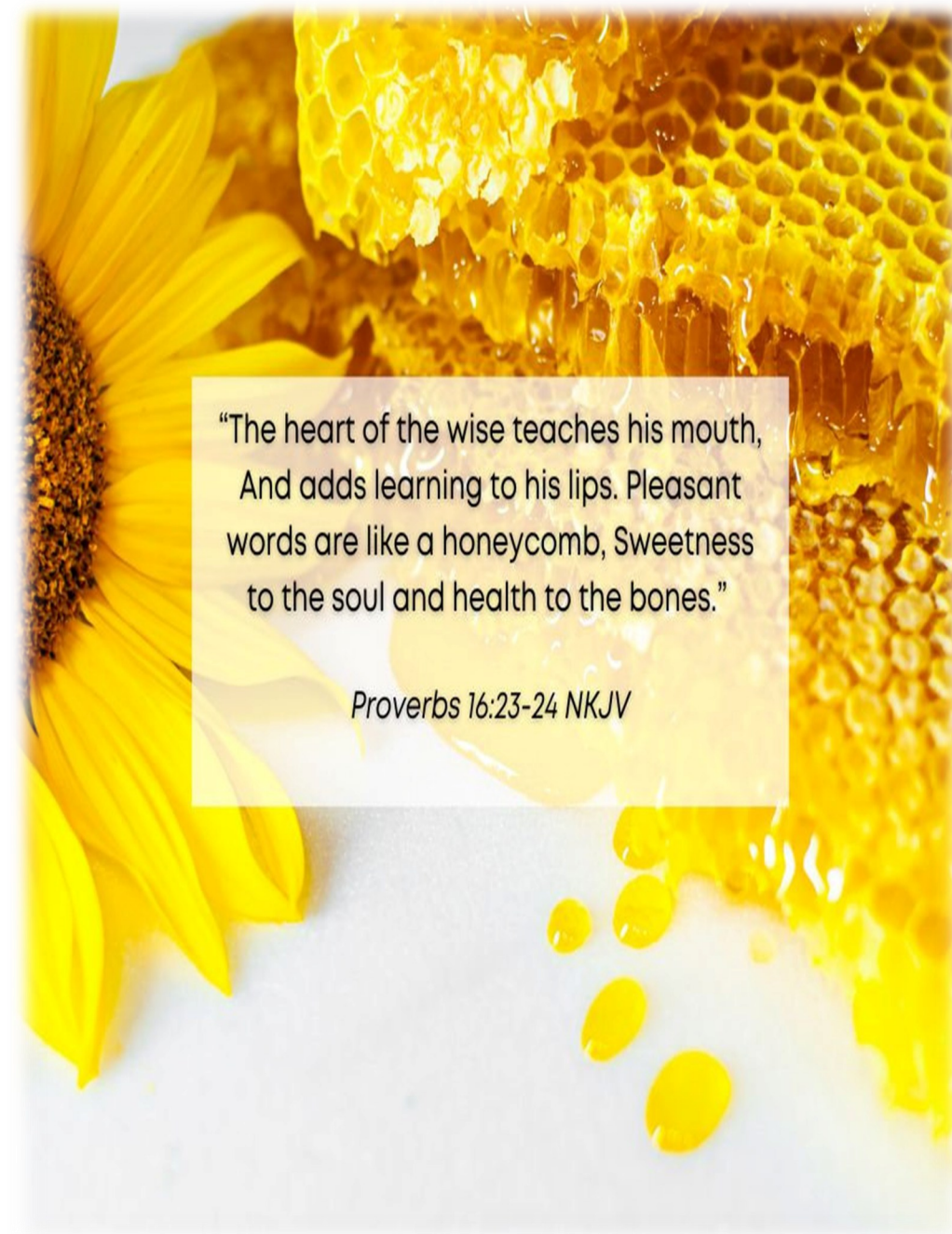
